- 7. To comply with the salary transfer policy of CYCU, the deposit will be refunded for the student who completes a full academic year accommodation. The refunds will be returned to the student's bank account without interest. It requires students to provide the bank accounts (Chunghwa Post Co., Ltd., Mega International Commercial Bank) for the Division of Cashier Affair.
