

CYCU Directions Governing Students' Health Examination

- Article 1. The Directions are established in accordance with the “Implementation Regulations Governing Health Examination of Students” promulgated by Ministry of Education order under Tai-Can-Zi No. 0920082231A and CYCU’s healthcare regulations, in order to maintain CYCU students’ health, discover diseases earlier and follow up and correct the diseases, and prevent communicable diseases from breaking out on campus.
- Article 2. Subjects of health examination: CYCU educational system freshmen, exchange students who have stayed for more than six (6) months, transfer students, and re-entry students.
- Article 3. Health Services Division, Office of Student Affairs shall conduct the students’ health examination based on the scope of health examination referred to in the students’ health examination guidebook issued by Ministry of Education, and ask the students undergoing the health examination to complete the health information (personal medical history and family medical history) survey form.
- Article 4. Where any student is found abnormal upon the health examination, Health Services Division shall guide him/her to seek referral service and help him/her take re-examination, and provide him/her with health education information and individual counseling.
- Article 5. Where any student is found suffering from any communicable disease according to the health examination result, Health Services Division shall adopt the communicable disease prevention measures and provide counseling service to the student pursuant to the relevant requirements about communicable diseases defined by Taiwan Centers for Disease Control.
- Article 6. According to Article 12 of School Health Act promulgated by Ministry of Education, schools shall conduct the case management for, and help arrangement of the activities attended by, students with heart disease, asthma, epilepsy, diabetes, hemophilia, cancer, mental illness, and any other major illness, and students with serious injuries and sickness.
- Article 7. The Directions are approved by the meeting of student affairs and shall be promulgated and enforced by the Principal. The same shall apply where the Directions are amended.
