

CYCU Directions Governing Prevention and Management of Infection of Tuberculosis in Campus

Approved at 3rd Meeting of Health Services Committee at 2nd semester of the school year of 2011 on July 4, 2012
Amended per the letter under Yuan-Mi-Zi No. 1050002657 dated August 25, 2016
Approved at 1st Meeting of Health and Dining Services Committee in the school year of 2020 on January 7, 2021

- Article 1. In addition to CYCU Regulations Governing Prevention of Infectious Diseases in Campus, the Directions are established in order to strengthen the prevention of Tuberculosis for the faculty and students throughout the school.
- Article 2. CYCU's personnel, including the whole faculty and students, employees by contract, exchange scholars and exchange students, shall submit their chest X-ray report issued by medical institutes/hospitals, or take CYCU's advice and arrangement for the X-ray inspection. If the chest X-ray report shows the possibility of Tuberculosis, please take more detailed inspection and therapy in medical institutions/hospitals promptly.
- Article 3. Any of CYCU's personnel who is diagnosed by medical institutions/hospitals as the patient of open Tuberculosis in school shall be suspended from working or attending class, and shall be isolated to take the relevant therapy.
- Article 4. Health Services Division shall follow up the faculty and students who suffer from Tuberculosis. The students shall not take too extreme exercise, and Athletic Department shall arrange the special physical education class for the students.
- Article 5. The borders that are isolated and under observation shall receive hospital treatment per the doctor's instruction when they are isolated and under observation. Those who do not need to be isolated or hospitalized shall return home to take rest, or move to the isolated and ventilated accommodation space arranged by Student Housing Service Division to avoid spreading pathogen.
- Article 6. Where the faculty and students on leave for Tuberculosis wish to end the leave for work or school, they shall present the certificate of diagnosis issued by medical institutions/hospitals to prove that they have already received perfect treatment and are unlikely to communicate the disease again. The same shall apply to the students on suspension of study for Tuberculosis who wish to apply for resumption of study.
- Article 7. CYCU's staff who have contacted any patient of open Tuberculosis closely shall take the chest X-ray inspection, and the periodical follow-up and management of Health Services Division.
- Article 8. The Directions are approved by the Meeting of Health and Dining Services Committee, and shall be promulgated and enforced by the Principal. The same shall apply where the Directions are amended.
