

CYCU Directions Governing Treatment of Emergency Injuries and Sickness of Faculty and Students

Approved by Meeting of Student Affairs in the school year of 2011 on March 20, 2012

- Article 1. The Directions are established in accordance with the “Guidelines Governing Treatment of Emergency Injuries and Sickness of School at All Levels Governed by Ministry of Education”, in order to ensure that CYCU’s faculty and students who suffer emergency injuries and sickness while in campus may be treated on the site immediately and seek the first aid.
- Article 2. Where any faculty or student suffers emergency injuries and sickness in the school, please report the same to Health Services Division of Office of Student Affairs (hereinafter referred to as the “Health Services Division”) during the service hours of the Health Services Division, or to the military instructor on duty of Campus Security Office out of said service hours.
- Article 3. The unit receiving the report shall verify the individual case voluntarily and send personnel to the site to provide treatment service, and contact student’s parents for necessary. The handling measures are as follows:
- (I) In the case of severe harm with a danger of life, call an ambulance and escort the injured to seek treatment immediately, and report to the related unit.
 - (II) In the case of sever harm without a danger of life but requiring medical treatment, arrange the transportation means and coordinate with related personnel to escort the injured to seek treatment.
 - (III) In the case of minor harm without a danger life or not requiring medical treatment, have the injured stay in the recovery room of Health Services Division for observation or return home after some preliminary medical treatment.
- Article 4. Any emergency injuries and sickness cases already seeking medical treatment shall be recorded completely.
- Article 5. Health Services Division shall prepare emergency medical gears and keep the gears active immediately to respond to any emergency injuries and sickness. The nursing staff shall take the in-service training in accordance with the Nursing Personnel Act.
- Article 6. The media speaking about the dispute or legal issues over the emergency injuries and sickness handled by CYCU’s staff, if any, shall be handled by the Center of Public Affairs.
- Article 7. The Directions are approved by the meeting of student affairs and shall be promulgated and enforced by the Principal. The same shall apply where the Directions are amended.
