- 1. To regulate the matters related to teaching assistants receiving scholarships for teaching and invigilation duties, these detailed rules are formulated in accordance with Article 10 of the "Regulations for Scholarships for Outstanding Graduate and Undergraduate Students of Chung Yuan Christian University".
- 2. Those who fail to assist in teaching or invigilation duties properly (such as carelessly grading assignments or reading books, chatting during invigilation, etc.) may have their eligibility for reapplying for scholarships canceled upon recommendation or disposition by the respective departments, and the matter will be handled by the Student Affairs Office.
- 3. Those who arbitrarily ask others to substitute their assigned work without approval will have their eligibility for reapplying for scholarships canceled.
- 4. If the disposition is deemed illegal or improper, resulting in damage to their rights, they may file an appeal to the "Student Learning and Labor Rights Handling Group" within thirty days from the day after receiving the disposition notice.
- 5. These detailed rules shall be implemented after being approved by the Student Affairs Meeting and announced by the President. The same applies to amendments.
