

# **CYCU Directions for Outstanding Graduate School Overseas Chinese Students Scholarship**

Passed at the Meeting of Student Affairs on December 30, 2020

- I. To encourage outstanding overseas Chinese students to study at our graduate school, these guidelines are formulated based on the "Ministry of Education's Guidelines for Universities to Set Up Scholarships for Outstanding Overseas Chinese Students in Graduate Schools."
- II. Eligibility :
  1. Outstanding overseas Chinese students who come to Taiwan to study at our graduate school according to the Regulations for Overseas Chinese Students Returning to Study and Counseling.
  2. Students who have formal graduate school status at our university (excluding extended students) and have completed at least one semester (including direct admission to the doctoral program).
  3. Students who take at least 6 credits each semester, with an academic performance of 80 points or above and a conduct score of 80 points or above in the previous semester.
  4. Students who have already received government-provided tuition fee subsidies, reductions, or other scholarships are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- III. Number of Scholarships : The number of scholarships is allocated by the Ministry of Education based on the number of overseas Chinese students in the graduate school each semester.
- IV. Scholarship Amount : Each student will receive no less than NT\$10,000 per month.
- V. Application Materials :
  1. One application form, signed and recommended by a professor from the department.
  2. One transcript of the previous semester (with class ranking).
  3. One resume.
  4. Relevant certificates, if any.
- VI. Application Period : Applications are processed in early March and October each year. Applicants must submit the required materials to the Office of Student Affairs Student Advising Division within 10 days from the announcement date (excluding holidays).
- VII. Review Process : A special committee formed by the Office of Student Affairs will conduct the selection and determine the list of scholarship recipients based on the approved quota.
- VIII. Suspension of Scholarship :
  1. If a scholarship recipient takes a leave of absence, withdraws, transfers to another school, changes their student status, or loses their student status, the scholarship will be suspended from the following month of the effective date.

2. If a scholarship recipient receives a demerit or higher disciplinary action during the academic year, the scholarship will be suspended from the following month of the school's announcement.
  3. If a scholarship recipient is found to have falsified or provided false information, the scholarship will be stopped, and the received scholarship will be recovered. Legal responsibilities will be pursued based on the severity of the case.
- IX. Replacement: If a scholarship recipient's scholarship is suspended due to the above reasons, the first alternate candidate will be selected as a replacement.
- X. Implementation: These guidelines are approved by the Student Affairs Meeting and reported to the President for implementation. The same applies to any amendments
