

CYCU Articles of Establishment of the Life Education Promotion Committee

Approved by the 1021st Administrative Meeting on April 11, 2024

Article 1. Chung Yuan Christian University (hereinafter referred to as the University), in accordance with the Ministry of Education's "Life Education Promotion Program" and the University's educational goals and philosophy, aims to promote related life education work, enhance students' physical and mental health, foster holistic development, understand the meaning and value of life, and cultivate a correct outlook on life. Therefore, the "Life Education Promotion Committee" (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) is established, and these regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) are hereby stipulated.

Article 2. The tasks of the Committee are as follows:

1. To cooperate with the Ministry of Education in formulating the University's life education promotion plan.
2. To assist and provide consultations on matters related to life education.
3. To supervise and evaluate the results of the University's life education promotion efforts.

Article 3. The Committee consists of thirteen to seventeen members. The Dean of Student Affairs, the Dean of Academic Affairs, the Director of the General Education Center, the Director of the Chaplaincy Office, and the Director of the Counseling Center are ex-officio members. Other members include one faculty representative from each college who has received the Excellent Mentor Award. Colleges with fewer than five academic units may choose not to recommend a representative. Additionally, the Extracurricular Activity Guidance Section will recommend student representatives, with the proportion of student representatives not less than one-tenth of the total number of committee members. The President appoints one Vice President or Chief Secretary as the Chairperson, and the Dean of Student Affairs serves as the Executive Secretary. Committee members serve a one-year term, appointed by the President.

Article 4. The Committee holds one meeting per academic year in principle, convened by the Chairperson. Additional meetings may be held as necessary to review the implementation results of various work objectives. Meetings require the attendance of more than half of the members, and resolutions are passed with the approval of more than half of those present.

Article 5. These Regulations shall be promulgated and implemented by the President after approval by the Administrative Meeting. The same procedure applies for amendments.
