Enforcement Directives for Transportation Fee Application for Students with Disabilities at Chung Yuan Christian University

- I. Chung Yuan Christian University (hereinafter referred to as the University) has formulated the "Enforcement Directives for Transportation Fee Application for Students with Disabilities at Chung Yuan Christian University" (hereinafter referred to as these Directives) in accordance with the Ministry of Education's Regulations on transportation services for students with disabilities who are unable to commute independently and the MOE's Implementation Directions for Subsidizing University Admission and Supporting Plan for Students with Disabilities.
- II. Students with disabilities applying for transportation fee subsidies must meet the following three criteria:
 - (I) Students who have a placement at the University and have a "Certificate of Identification for Special Education Students" issued by the Committee Responsible for Identification and Placement of Special Education Students of the Ministry of Education.
 - (II) Students who do not reside in the University's dormitories.
 - (III) Students who are unable to commute to/from the University.
- III. The application form for transportation fee subsidies for students with disabilities must be filled in by the student himself/herself, his/her legal guardian or his/her actual caregiver, with relevant documents enclosed to be submitted to the Resource Center for Students with Special Educational Needs within two weeks of the commencement of the University's school year. After a professional evaluation, approvals for students with disabilities who are deemed unable to commute to and from the University must be approved by the University's Special Education Promotion Committee. A list of their names will be compiled and submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval.
- IV. For students with disabilities who have been approved for the transportation fee subsidies, the University will make a record of the approval date and reference number alongside the review results to be submitted to the Special Education Promotion Committee. Fee subsidies will be allocated subject to approval by the Ministry of Education. Re-

- application is exempted during the period of study of the student at the University, unless there is a change to the criteria specified in Item 3.
- V. The amount of the transportation fee subsidy is subject to the regulations of the Ministry of Education. If the Ministry has not yet allocated the transportation subsidy, the University will advance the payment.
- VI. The Enforcement Directives shall be implemented after being approved by the Special Education Promotion Committee and reported to the Principal for promulgation. The same applies to revisions.
